- **15**th **February 2019,** EACO will communicate to authors whose presentations will have been accepted by the technical reviewing committee.
- 1st March 2019, submission of completed presentation in its final format to EACO. Each paper will be screened by a team of experts to assure its quality of exposition and relevance to the call.
- Successful authors will be invited to present their papers at the 4th e-waste management workshop scheduled for 18th 20th in Bujumbura, Burundi. Every invited author should make every effort to attend the workshop and present his/her paper.
