

Environmental Risks of e-waste

- ► E-waste can be toxic, it's not biodegradable and accumulates in the environment, in the soil, air, water and living things
- ➢Open-air burning and acid baths being used to recover valuable materials from electronic components release toxic materials leaching into the environment.
- ➤These practices can also expose workers to high levels of contaminants such as lead, mercury, beryllium, thallium, cadmium and arsenic, and also brominated flame retardants (BFRs) and polychlorinated biphenyls, which can lead to irreversible health effects, including cancers, miscarriages,

Health Effects

Most Electronic Waste contains hazardous substances that affect the environment and health, including

Lead

Destroys the nervous system, endocrine glands, kidneys, blood system and brain development of children.

Chlorine

In plastic, PVC is a carcinogen when the plastic is burned, it will affect the respiratory system, nasal irritation, and cause tooth decay. Mercury

It is harmful to the central nervous system. Including the brain and spinal cord. Cause lose control about the movement of arms, legs, speech, vision.

Cadmium

With acute poisoning, causes severe lung inflammation, kidney failure, kidney damage.

Bromine

It is a carcinogen. Causing biochemical changes and the shape of the heart muscle fibers.


